Purpose of the meeting 2016 CDBG First Public Hearing

In attendance: Supervisors Rearick, Southworth and Palmer, Secretary Davis, Kathy Heilman of the County Planning Dept., and Sgt. Bish  
Citizens: Matt Pfeil, Chad Evans, Gabe Lytle, Jonathon Weaver from The Kittanning Paper and Brad Pedersen from the Leader Times.

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Rearick. Stated purpose of the meeting was 2016 CDBG Funds and turned the meeting over to Kathy Heilman.

Kathy stated the anticipated funds for 2016 will be approximately \$84,775.00 with 18% being paid to the County for administration. \$69,479.00 would be available for programming with \$15,296.00 budgeted for administrative costs. Each project done must meet the LMI benefit of 51% for the affected area. Kathy stated she still needs 1 income survey to see if Iseman Hill is a qualifying project. Reviewed the long term plan and discussed removing street signs Township wide, paving of fire hall parking lot and resurfacing Short Street those projects have been done. Southworth would like to survey Goat Hill area to add guardrails, drainage and pave the road. The second public hearing will be held August 3, 2016.

Open to floor for comments:

Matt Pfeil - ask if water could be extended to Nunamaker Hill. Rearick told him extending water to Smeltzer Flats and Nunamaker was already on the long term plan.

Motion to adjourn by Rearick, seconded by Southworth, unanimous.
