Purpose of the meeting was to start preparing the 2016 Budget.

In attendance: Supervisors McGinnis, Rearick, Fabian, Secy. Davis and Road Foreman Robert Southworth

Citizens: Jonathan Weaver from The Kittanning Paper

Meeting was called to order by Chmn. McGinnis.

The Board worked on the State fund, Street Light fund, Fire Hydrant Fund and the Capital Reserve Fund for the 2016 budget. They would like to have a budget proposal from the fire department for the next meeting.

Rearick made a motion to adopt Resolution 15-6 to put all of Overbrook Drive on the liquid fuels list, seconded by Fabian, unanimous.

Davis told the Board to abandon Quay Street they have to hold a hearing and give written notice of the hearing to property owners adjacent to the road. Davis is to contact the Solicitor to see what has to happen at the hearing and who all has to be notified. Davis gave the Board a copy of the compensatory time page from the handbook for their review.

Davis gave a comparison of uniforms from Cintas and UniFirst. Southworth and Davis to meet and compare the quality of clothes.

Fabian made a motion to refund \$3,850 to H.I.S. Enterprises since their stormwater plan is complete, seconded by McGinnis, unanimous.

Rearick made a motion to have Senate review the Stormwater Ordinance and see if it needs to be as stringent and make any changes, seconded by Fabian, unanimous.

ASD would like lines on Buffington Drive. An approximate price would be \$2,366.00.

The Board is alright with lines being painted after our Solicitor would draw up a maintenance agreement so ASD would be responsible to maintain the lines.

There are no parking signs on Chaplain across from the Adult Learning Center. Dawn Kocher-Taylor requested these be removed because on Mondays the parking lot is full and she has students parking there. The Board agreed to remove the signs but leave the poles in for now and have her tell the students may get plowed in.

Fabian ask if we have a police proposal ready for Ford City for tonight, he was told it is still being worked on.

Fabian stated there is a woman on Park Avenue who would like to trim trees that are hanging on her property. Board agreed it would be alright for her to have them trimmed.

Fabian also stated there is an abundance of cats on Park Avenue.
