Purpose of the meeting was to prepare the 2017 Budget.

In attendance: Supervisors Rearick, Southworth and Palmer, Secretary Davis, Sgt. Bish, Cpl. Petrosky and Officer Markilinski  
Citizens: Mike Sante, Jonathan Weaver of The Kittanning Paper

Meeting was called to order by Chmn. Rearick. Secy. Davis presented copies of computer printouts containing the past 3 year's activity, 2016 usage to date with 2016 budget figures for the general fund.

Rearick made a motion to set Trick-or-Treat from 6:00P.M. to 8:00P.M. on October 26<sup>th</sup>, seconded by Palmer, unanimous.

There is an event at the Horse Park on October 8<sup>th</sup> and the Board has been ask to be the judges for the chili cook-off. Everyone agreed to be judges.

Rearick made a motion to vote to elect Michael Keller as a trustee for the Health insurance cooperative trust and the unemployment compensation group trust, seconded by Palmer, unanimous.

Davis received an application for a large gathering at High Voltage for October 1<sup>st</sup>. This will be their first day open after being closed for a while. Mike Sante stated he has watered the track and the DJ will be done between 10:00P.M. and 11:00P.M. Rearick made a motion to sign the permit, seconded by Palmer, unanimous. He would like to work on a haunted trail and hayride, Board told him to apply for a permit.

Large gathering ordinance Sacco stated a fee scale based on the number of individuals is a good idea. Davis gave the Board copies of 2 ordinances supplied by Sacco concerning junk cars.

Police Business:

Officer Brice got a quote of \$242.90 for 2 sets of weathertech floor liners for the front floors of both SUVs. The Board approved the purchase.

Davis stated the Police Department computers have been having issues the last few days. The Board approved purchasing 2 Dell computers with Microsoft office and Adobe in the package.

Cpl. Petrosky stated he would like to hire 4 officers. Rearick made a motion to advertise and collect applications and then interview all candidates, seconded by Southworth, unanimous.

Other Business:

Davis and Cpl. Petrosky stated there is a need for a sign near the road stating this is the Municipal Office and the Police Department. They are to get quotes on a sign.

Cpl. Petrosky stated he would like to start to working towards getting the department accredited. He attended a class on this subject. The Board agreed to look at this process.

Palmer stated he will not be at the October 5<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Comments:

Jonathan Weaver – Ask if there will be any tax increase in 2017 and was told no. Ask when next budget meeting was scheduled, he was told at 5:00P.M. on October 13<sup>th</sup>.
